2022 University Recommended Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship (The International Priority Graduate Program : Brain-Food PGP)

Muroran Institute of Technology (MuroranIT) has established a new International Priority Graduate Program (PGP) called "Practical education program through development of a novel functional index of food to prevent brain aging (Brain-Food PGP)".

Therefore, it would be appreciated if you could make an announcement of the MEXT Scholarship at your university. We would like students or graduates from your university to apply for this scholarship recommendation. Admission quota for program is 7 students, and **3 students in the quota will be supported from the Japanese Government (MEXT) Scholarship.** The MEXT scholarship students are eligible only for international students from priority countries designated by Japanese Government. Notice:

1. Upon receipt of applications, PGP will choose the final candidates through document screening and online interview including presentation to be held on January 28 of 2022 and recommend them to MEXT.

2. Please note that the applicant should contact one of the PGP faculty members and get permission for acceptance from his or her intended supervisor at MuroranIT in advance of an application to MuroranIT. Thus, please instruct your applicant to have a full discussion with a PGP faculty regarding the permission for acceptance and research plan by the due date of application as specified below.

3. Please note that **the deadline for applications is January 14, 2022.**

*In case it is difficult to submit the documents due to COVID-19, please inform us in advance.

4. Priority countries (Southeast Asia, Southwest Asia, Mongolia) :
India, Indonesia, Cambodia, Singapore, Sri Lanka, Thailand, Nepal, Pakistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, Philippines, Brunei, Vietnam, Malaysia, Myanmar, Maldives, Mongolia, Laos

5. In parallel with the selection of the scholarship, the admission application and entrance procedure for doctoral course are also necessary and should be done by the scholar applicant. The application period for admission to the Doctoral Course will be June 2022.

6. Depending upon the circumstances of COVID-19, the schedule may be changed. Therefore, we would like to request a careful consideration by each applicant to this matter before his or her application.
